The World Council of Optometry is pleased to announce that it is accepting nominations for the 2010 International Optometrist of the Year Award. This award is given annually to an optometrist who has shown outstanding commitment, both to the profession and the community at large. Serving Governing Board members should not receive an award until they have been off the Board for at least two years.

The selection Panel for Awards will be chaired by the President Elect and includes two past presidents. The names of nominees will not be revealed unless the selection panel makes a recommendation to the Governing Board. It was agreed unanimously that a nominee who received two thirds of the GB votes would be approved for an award.

The selection panel would review nominations and present recommendation to the GB. It is planned that WCO awards would be presenting during WCO meetings in Durban, September 2010.
